PEDAL FOR PROMISE IS A 13, 22 OR 50 MILE BIKE RIDE BETWEEN MEDFORD AND TUCKERTON, NJ.

Your involvement in the Pedal for Promise will help support the dynamic education taking place at UrbanPromise Academy (UPA). Founded in 1997 by UrbanPromise Ministries, UPA offers Camden teens a unique private Christian schooling opportunity.

The academy has seen tremendous success in preparing teens for post-secondary educational opportunities by engaging teens in a unique education experience that includes: low student/teacher ratios, a family style learning environment, personal accountability, community service, mentoring, weekly Bible classes and an emphasis on experiential learning through the UrbanTrekks Program. UrbanTrekks takes teens out of the classroom and into the outdoors, providing them with hands-on, up-close learning and mentoring.

Each rider is asked to have a goal of fundraising at least \$200 for UrbanPromise Academy.
